Recent research indicates that between 2013 and 2020, the number of Albertans between the ages of 15 and 19 who used vaping products rose to 35% from 18%. Our youth are increasingly engaging in experimentation with vaping products at a startling rate and at younger ages. I am continuing to work with community partners and have conversations with our students and parents regarding how to combat vaping in our school and support students with cessation.

Your responses provide us with valuable feedback about our school that we use to help guide our planning to enhance your child's experience at HJ Cody.
